One class: Christ-centered Worship, with Dr. Zac Hicks, will teach students how to plan and lead worship with varied instruments and styles, but consistent, steady content. Ethics and the Follower of Christ, with our newest faculty member Dr. Nathan Olson, will answer the question "How do we live?" And Pastor Gary Jorgenson will lead a GREAT study in 1 & 2 Peter, a study our congregation has enjoyed this spring.

Three days: The second session of classes begins after lunch on Wednesday and concludes before dinner on Friday. You could sleep in your own bed on Friday night, return home Saturday morning, or enjoy the weekend in Minneapolis.

150 dollars: Meals are separate, and you can find a hotel nearby (on-campus housing is for full-week guests only). We'll even throw in a Wednesday night BBQ for free.

Return home recharged: You will love what you learn, and those with whom you learned. You will take home a renewed focus on Christ-centered worship, a better understanding of Christian ethics, or a full fall of Bible Study prepared and ready to go. You'll come back for the full week in a year— and bring friends.
